## NEW LIBRARY PROTOCOL

In reviewing the borrowing system at school, we have identified that the overdue system needs an overhaul! The purpose of a library is to provide students with access to library books that they are able to borrow and are encouraged to read (at any opportunity), and staff have raised concerns that there are many students who miss out on this opportunity regularly as they have overdue books to return!

The overdue list will continue to be circulated weekly to teaching staff to assist students in their returning responsibility, however, we will no longer be sending out letters to individual families on a weekly basis, as it is the student's responsibility to return the books in a timely manner. Letters will be sent out monthly, to align with the billing cycle of the school.

This small change means that students may continue to borrow during a month, even if they have overdue books. If students have overdue books at the conclusion of the month, letters will be sent home for families to assist students in the returns process and recovery of school property.

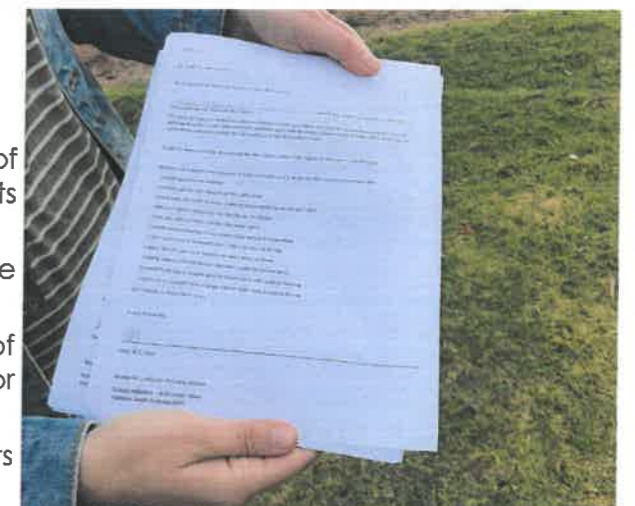
## YEAR 4/5 ACTION

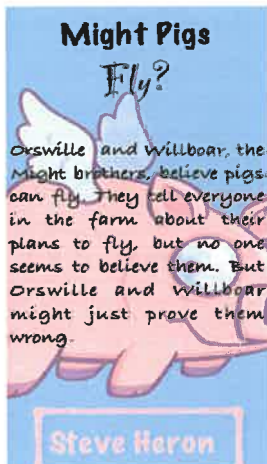
