Join us for a Celebration and Lunch

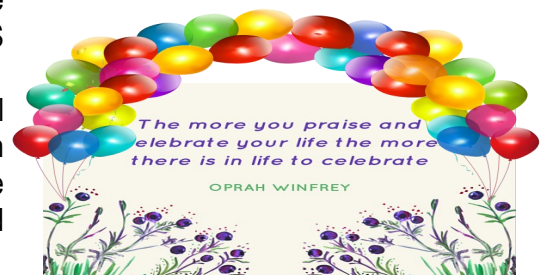


Sunday 5th of February (end of Week1)
